TRAINER

Mr. Prathamesh D. Papat (founder: **Prachi Mediation Training Institute**) is an Advocate, an Accredited Mediator and a Senior Mediation Trainer of MCPC. He has Mediation experience spanning over two decades and conducts basic and advanced workshops for training mediators since 2007.

He is an empanelled Mediator in several institutions, including the Bombay High Court and mediates disputes referred to him directly as well as by various courts. He regularly trains professionals, students and others in the art of Mediation & Conciliation. He is a certified Mediator of IMI (International Mediation Institute) based in The Hague. He has authored several articles on Mediation, has contributed to several international publications and is the author of the Monograph Series publication of the CTC (Chamber of Tax Consultants) on the topic of **Mediation & Conciliation**.

OBJECTIVES

The law on Mediation as now being inactive into law and shall be shortly implemented. Soon a large number of matters, which would otherwise had directed to the doors of courts of justice,

will now be required to be first mediated. This will hence require a large number of trained mediators.

The success of the Mediation process depends upon the ability and skill of the Mediator in collaboratively engaging the parties in this process so as to create an environment that encourages a meaningful dialogue focused on addressing the concerns and interests of the disputing parties.

The intent and content of the workshop is to give the Participants a hands-on experience in learning the skills of a mediator. It will hence enable the participants to not only get a sense of the Mediation as a process but will also afford them the opportunity to systematically understand the role of the Mediator so as to be able to grasp the concepts, learn the techniques and practice them.
