# 1. Cable car operators "are back stronger than ever"- Interalpine Tyrol

The Interalpin trade fair in Innsbruck was officially opened on Wednesday. Everything that is of rank and repute in the ropeway industry is also represented there on Thursday and Friday. "We're back, stronger and better than ever before," said Austria's top cable car operator Franz Hörl at the opening. "The fair is a platform for exchange, partnerships and friendships," said Fair Director Christian Mayerhofer. For WK President Christoph Walser, the Interalpin is "the leading trade fair in the alpine area and Tyrol is the world market leader in the cable car business".

Innsbruck's Mayor Georg Willi (Greens) said that "the first Interalpin took place 50 years ago as a small trade fair in Igls. Today it is the most popular trade fair worldwide in the ropeway business".

Minister of Transport from India special guest

Meanwhile, LH Anton Mattle (ÖVP) reminded that "Tyrol has recognized the opportunity of tourism. With the cable cars, he was significantly advanced. The industry provides added value for the population and secures jobs in the valleys".

**India's Transport Minister Nitin Gadkari** was welcomed as a special guest. The cable car business is really flourishing there. "In the next five years alone, we will invest five trillion dollars in various projects." Austria and Tyrol are important partners.

650 exhibitors show the latest innovations

Around 650 exhibitors present themselves on around 40,000 square meters of space. The "Tiroler Krone" stopped by to see them. Doppelmayr has been using cable cars as a form of public transport for years. "Cableways do not emit any emissions,

take up little space on the ground and are quick to build and cheap compared to other means of transport," explained Julia Schwärzler.

Ski resorts are currently investing more in summer sports. "Mountain biking is developing into a popular sport, as many routes are being built for families," said Gottfried Gram from Smart Solution. Snow gun manufacturers like Technoalpin also boom when there is little snow. The mountain rescue outfitter Tyromont is also doing good business because, according to marketing manager Bernhard Schönherr, there are unfortunately more and more accidents in the mountains.

New opportunities, but also new challenges for alpine sports

At the Interalpin, it's all about how you can best use the mountain. For many ski areas, the summer program is becoming more and more important. If there is no snow for skiing, you can go down by bike, for example. The ropeway manufacturer Doppelmayr developed new ways of transporting bicycles in gondolas.

Because of the boom in mountaineering, however, mountain rescue is required to do two or three things. "Especially due to the ski touring and e-bike boom since Corona, many people end up in the mountains without experience, know-how and the right equipment," says exhibitor Bernhard Schönherr, "Furthermore, many guests are out and about with dogs on the mountain, which is why Tyromont has a harness for rescuing dogs from gondolas. The harness can also be used for avalanche dogs."

### 2. India and Russia are planning free trade agreements

There is an advance agreement on a free trade agreement, Indian Foreign Minister Subrahmanyam Jaishankar said at an event in New Delhi. Due to Western sanctions over the Ukraine war, the Russian government wants to expand its trade relations with other countries, especially in Asia.

Russia, for example, has become India's most important supplier of crude oil, overtaking Iraq. Imports nearly quadrupled to \$46.33 billion in the 12 months ended March 31. Now the machine imports from India are to be increased. According to Reuters, the Russian government may want to import more than 500 products from the Asian country for cars, planes and trains. The reason: The core industry is becoming increasingly difficult to keep running.

#### Russian technology, Indian pharmaceuticals

India, in turn, is keen to reduce its growing trade deficit with Russia. The country is the largest supplier of military equipment and the fourth largest market for Indian pharmaceuticals. Foreign Minister Jaishankar said his country's economy could benefit from the technology. The government is therefore working to solve the problems with payments, certification and logistics.
