- 1. <u>Bilateral:</u> Special session on India-Kazakhstan relations held in Kolkata: Ambassador of Kazakhstan to India N. Zhalgasbayev took part in a Special Session on India and Kazakhstan Emerging ties: Focus on West Bengal. The event, organized by the Merchant Chamber of Commerce and Industry (MCCI) of West Bengal, was attended by more than 100 representatives of local large, small and medium-sized businesses, business community, public figures and mass media. During the visit, Zhalgasbayev held a meeting with Vandana Yadav, Principal Secretary, Department of Industry, Commerce and Enterprises, Government of West Bengal, during which the sides exchanged views on the current state and prospects of trade and economic, investment cooperation, and discussed possible ways of its further development.
- 2. President Tokayev proposes setting up SCO investment fund: President Tokayev outlined priorities of strategic importance under Kazakhstan's upcoming chairmanship of the Shanghai Cooperation Organization (SCO) following the July 4 SCO Summit online. a). The President proposed to the SCO Council of Heads of Government to consider establishing a joint Investment Fund. The Astana International Financial Centre (AIFC) can be an effective platform for stimulating direct and portfolio investments in regional SCO projects. The SCO's economic agenda should prioritize creating favorable conditions for mutual trade growth, removing existing trade barriers and launching joint ventures. b). The systematic reduction of the digital divide different countries and social groups must become a real priority in the work of the SCO. India, during its presidency in the SCO, has done a lot of work to develop cooperation in this direction. According to Tokayev, favorable conditions have been created in Kazakhstan for a comprehensive digital transformation. The country ranked 28th in the UN E-Government Development Index last year, the highest position among the SCO member states. Kazakhstan offers its services as a digital hub in the SCO space. Therefore, the President believes it is important to host the SCO Digital Forum in Astana in 2024. c). The President Tokayev has initiated adopting the SCO's Anti-Drug Strategy for 2024-2029 and the Action Program on its implementation. All these measures will help promote sustainability and ensure security in the SCO space.
- 3. PM Smailov invited INNOPROM exhibition participants to field exposition in Astana: Speaking at the XIII International Industrial Exhibition on Monday in Yekaterinburg PM Smailov invited participants of the INNOPROM exhibition to take part in the field exposition dedicated to innovative industry, which will be held on September 25-27

in Astana. INNOPROM is a three-day traveling exhibition. The exhibition would host the national expositions and individual companies from the EAEU member countries, Pakistan, Turkey, India, Iran, and Azerbaijan.
