- F. Enhancing economic relationship between India and Ukraine
- 1. Background: India is one of Ukraine's largest export destination in the Asia

Pacific and among the top 10 overall export destination. Main items for export from Ukraine to India are agricultural products (mainly sunflower oil), Fertilizers, Chemicals, Plastic, Wood articles, Iron and Steel products, etc. while pharmaceuticals, Misc. Chemicals, Components of nuclear reactors and boilers, etc are the major Indian exports to Ukraine. India is the biggest destination for Ukrainian sunflower oil.

2. Bilateral Trade: Bilateral trade between the two countries has grown significantly in the last 25 years. Bilateral trade between India and Ukraine was US\$ 3.386 billion in 2021-22 (Department of Commerce, GOI). India's exports increased from US \$ 450.97 Million in 2020-21 to US \$ 472.68 Million in 2021-22 (Department of Commerce, GOI). The trade figures for the last 5 years are as follows:

- **3. Tourism**: Due to the conflict situation and travel restrictions introduced by Ukraine's Martial law, tourist flow into India has been significantly reduced. Also, due to the travel advisories issued by GOI, very few Indian national travel to Ukraine. The revenue from tourism in Ukraine has been reduced by 18 % (source: State tourist agency, Ukraine).
