The Managing Committee of IMC Chamber of Commerce and Industry (Formerly: Indian Merchants' Chamber) (hereinafter referred to as "the Chamber") appointed me on May 5, 2022 as the Scrutinizer for the Remote E-voting process as well as to scrutinize the votes cast through ballot form by the members of the Chamber at the venue of the Annual General Meeting pursuant to Section 108 of the Companies Act, 2013 read with Rule 20 of the Companies (Management and Administration) Rules, 2014 as amended.

Report on Scrutiny:

- The Chamber had appointed Central Depository Services Lamited ("CDSL") as the Service Provider for the purpose of extending the facility of Remote E-Voting to the Members of the Chamber.
- CDSL had provided a system for recording the votes of the Members electronically on all the items of the business sought to be transacted at the AGM of the Chamber, which was held on Wednesday, 29th June, 2022.
- CDSL had set up electronic voting facility on their website, https://www.evotingindia.com. The
 Chamber had uploaded all the items of the business to be transacted at the AGM on the website of
 the Chamber and also on the Service Provider to facilitate their Members to cast their vote through
 Remote E-Voting.
- The Cut-off date for the purposes of identifying the Members who were entitled to vote on the resolutions placed for approval of the Members was 31st January, 2022.
- The Remote E-Voting facility was open from Friday, 24th June, 2022 at 9.00 A.M. to Tuesday, 28th June, 2022 at 5:00 P.M.
- At the venue of the AGM of the Chamber, the facility to vote through Ballot Form was provided to
 facilitate those members present at the meeting but could not participate and cast their votes by
 availing the Remote E voting facility.
- The Chairman, at the end of the discussion on the resolutions on which voting were to be held in
 physical mode, allowed voting by ballot form for all those members who were present at the AGM
 but could not cast their votes through remote e-voting facility.
- At the venue of the AGM, 1 (one) ballot box was kept for the purpose of casting of physical votes.

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- After closure of the physical voting at the AGM, the ballot box was opened in my presence and in presence of two witnesses namely, Mr. Shivakumar P. S. and Mr. Hemang Dhakan and the ballot forms were diligently scrutinized and counted. The ballot forms were reconciled with the records maintained by the Chamber. The ballot form(s) which were found defective have been treated as invalid and kept separately.
- Thereafter, the Remote E Voting facility was duly unblocked by me as a Scrutinizer in the presence of Mr. Shivakumar P. S. and Mr. Hemang Dhakan as prescribed in Sub Rule 4(xii) of Rule 20 of the Companies (Management & Administration) Rules, 2014.
- Thereafter, I as a Scrutinizer duly compiled details of the Remote E-Voting carried out by the Members and the physical voting done at the venue of the AGM by way of ballot form, the details of which are as follows:
