According to insiders, Apple supplier Foxconn wants to significantly expand its iPhone capacities in India in order to compensate for the production problems in China caused by lockdowns and the zero-Covid policy.

The Taiwan-based group plans to quadruple its workforce to 70,000 in two years at a plant it opened in India in 2019, two Indian government officials familiar with the matter said.

iPhone production suffers from corona measures

Apple recently had to agree with its customers that deliveries of the iPhone 14 model will be delayed due to the corona restrictions in China. Foxconn is responsible for 70 percent of iPhone production.

Most are manufactured at the plant in Zhengzhou, China, which employs around 200,000 people. However, there is currently only limited production there due to the corona lockdowns, and many employees fled the plant.
