President Isaias Afwerki meets with a high level Italian delegation led by Mr. Francesco Lollobrigida Minister of Agriculture, Food Sovereignty and Forests and with deputy Minister of Foreign Affairs and International Cooperation Mr. Edmondo Cirielli.

The comprehensive plan of action, signed in the presence of President Isaias Afwerki, aims to deepen strategic collaboration in key areas, including Energy, Infrastructure, Agriculture, Fisheries, Tourism, Culture, Sports and Maritime Security and other areas. The agreement was formally signed by Eritrea's Minister of Trade and Industry, Mr. Nesredin Mohammed Saleh and Mr. Edmondo Cirielli.

Both nations have agreed to organize a future business forum to facilitate further engagement.
