Semiconductor exports reached USD 13.06 billion, boosted by reduced inventories and rising demand, while mobile phone and computer exports grew due to increased component shipments and AI-driven demand for memory devices. On the import side, the U.S., Japan, and Vietnam saw modest increases, while imports from China dropped significantly by 22.5%.</p> <p>Korea, U.S. Agree to Launch Tariff Consultations</p> <p>On April 24, Trade Minister Dukgeun Ahn and Deputy Prime Minister Choi Sang-mok held the Korea-U.S. 2+2 Trade Dialogue in Washington, D.C. Minister Ahn later met with the U.S. Trade Representative (USTR), where both sides agreed to begin working-level consultations on tariff issues as soon as possible. In the dialogue, Ahn urged the U.S. to exempt Korea from all current and future tariffs, including those on autos and steel. Both sides reached a principled agreement to establish a consultation framework, with working-level talks set for next week to define the scope and format. Coordination will continue with relevant ministries and Korea's Economic Security Strategy Task Force.</p>

They discussed deepening economic cooperation in strategic areas, including critical minerals and supply chains, and agreed to enhance collaboration on economic security and core technologies. The talks also covered progress on upgrading the Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement [CEPA] and expanding Korean participation in high-value infrastructure projects in India. The Synthetic Biology Promotion Act is set to take effect in 2026, one year after its promulgation, and the government plans to implement necessary follow-up measures, such as enacting enforcement ordinances and detailed guidelines.</p>
